# MUSEUM OF ART | FORT LAUDERDALE EXPANDS ITS MONTHLY "ART OF WINE AND FOOD" TASTING SERIES



#### WHO/WHAT:

The Museum of Art | Fort Lauderdale, Nova Southeastern University, continues its delectable wine and food pairings with exquisite art during its "Art of Wine and Food" tasting series. The once-amonth series gives attendees a social, fun and educational opportunity to learn about delicious wines and foods, as well as the chance to enjoy the Museum's current exhibitions *Pearl and Stanley Goodman Latin American Collection* and *Recent Acquisitions from the Museum's Latin* 

American Collection.

The series will be hosted by Stephanie Miskew, Certified Specialist of Wine, and author of the blog *Stephanie Savors the Moment*. Miskew works as a consultant organizing wine tastings, vintner dinners, and educational programs for both professional and charitable events. She also writes wine reviews and educational content for wine guru Gary Vaynerchuck's Web site, *Cork'd*.

Also hosting will be Chef John Paul Kline of Delray Beach-based John Paul Custom Cuisine. Chef John Paul is dedicated to artfully preparing the highest quality food, using the freshest ingredients possible. His degree is in Culinary Arts from Johnson & Wales Culinary Institute in Providence, RI with extensive experience as a personal chef on Nantucket and at acclaimed restaurants in New England and the eastern seaboard.

Each event will feature three to four wines presented with food pairings. Miskew will discuss the background and characteristics of each wine while Chef John Paul describes the inspiration and preparation of each dish. All wines to be provided by Republic National Distributing Company.

The Museum of Art | Fort Lauderdale, Nova Southeastern University, is open Tuesday – Saturday 11 am – 5 pm, with extended hours on Thursday until 8 pm, Sundays 12 pm – 5 pm, and closed on Mondays. The Museum of Art is located at One East Las Olas Boulevard at Andrews Avenue in Downtown Fort Lauderdale. Individual ticket prices for Pearl and Stanley Goodman Latin American Collection and Recent Acquisitions from the Museum's Latin American Collection (which includes admission to the entire Museum) are \$10 for adults, \$7 for seniors 65+, and \$5 for students 6-17. Group rates are available for groups of 10 or more by calling 954-262-0241. The Studio School offers art instruction for adults and students (grades 1 to 12) offers a 10-week program, taught by professional artists.
