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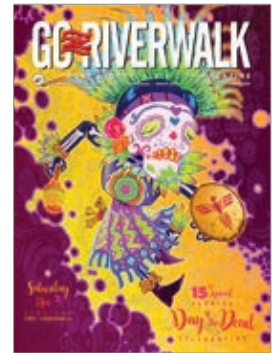

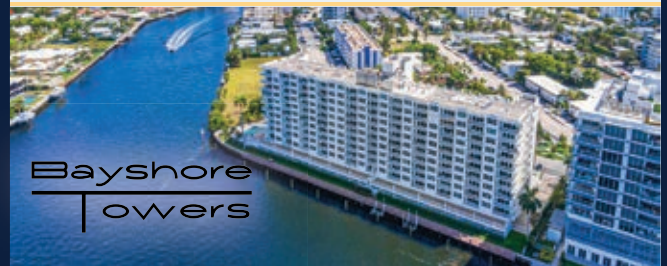

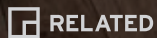

FORT LAUDERDALE INTERNATIONAL BOAT SHOW CELEBRATES 65 YEARS

When talking about economic engines for Fort Lauderdale, Broward County and the surrounding areas, the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show sits at the top of the list. From Oct. 30 to Nov. 3, the action is in full swing; however, months ahead, layout and design is in progress to best feature the participants, boats and services that will be presented. Forecasted to be \$1.7 billion economic impact, it hosts more than 100,00 attendees and many of which hub out of Riverwalk Laura Ward Plaza using the Fort Lauderdale Water Taxi as the best means of getting back and forth.

The show is owned by Marine Industries Association of South Florida and produced by Inform Markets on their behalf. This boat show is known to be the largest in-water show in the world. While there are thousands of boat options to be seen, toured and tried, there are additional seminars and clinics to educate. The options for a culinary experience are front and center with more than 100 food concessions and bars that offer everything from street tacos to gourmet meals. A plethora of cocktails and beers are offered throughout the area to be sure you stay hydrated!

You may choose to visit the Superyacht Village to admire some of the largest and most luxurious vessels offered for sale. You can meet with yacht builders and designers that

can help you select what your next yacht will be.

Historically there have been live demos in the Aqua Zone, which is a place to see some of the coolest demonstrations.

VIP ticket holders are afforded a preview day to experience the show ahead of the crowds and have a club atmosphere to relax and enjoy first class services including complimentary shuttle and water taxi service and access to other amenities.

This show provides the opportunity to see and learn about everything from your dinghy to your yacht. Whether it be sail or power boat, you will have access to new vessels and those gently used.

Experienced equipment and services are featured through the village permitting you to upgrade your existing vessel or to add new enhancements.

While the show is geared for boaters, it is also an event for all. Join Riverwalk in celebrating life on the water in Fort Lauderdale and how this one event impacts our community.

Fort Lauderdale is home to more than 165 miles of navigable waterways, home to the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show and where we live – I would say we are most fortunate 🌊



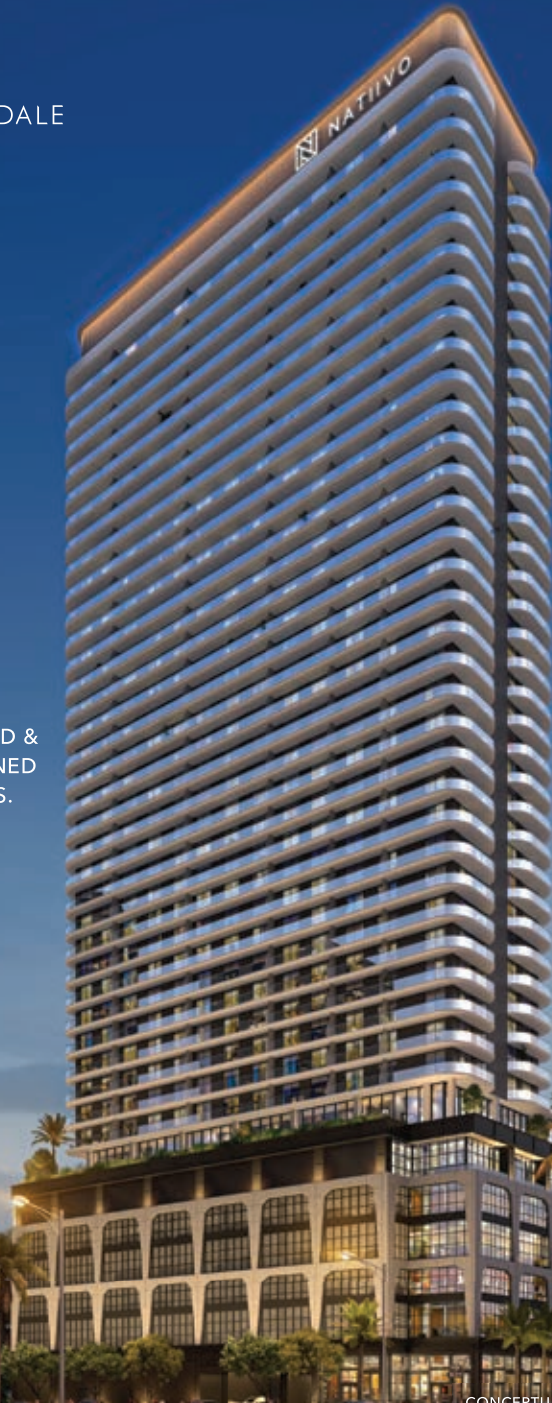

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# A SMOOTHER PARKING EXPERIENCE

UPDATES ON NOTABLE PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

The City of Fort Lauderdale is making strides to enhance parking and transportation infrastructure. Over the past year, significant upgrades have been made, particularly to our surface parking lots. Here's a look at some of the notable projects that have wrapped up, with more still in the pipeline.

## Nautical Parking Lot

Situated in the bustling Las Olas area, the Nautical Parking Lot received a major facelift. The project involved laying down around 2,600 square yards of FDOT Superpave 9.5 asphalt, fresh thermoplastic pavement markings, milling and replacing wheel stops. Additionally, the lot's existing asphalt was leveled and improvements to landscaping and irrigation were recommended. The project was completed in July 2024.

## North Beach/Temporary Fire Station 13

This two-phase project began with the design and construction of a new parking lot. Key upgrades included the addition of site lighting, drainage infrastructure, sidewalks, landscaping and irrigation.

The second phase involved setting up a temporary trailer for Fire Station No. 13, which will serve the battalion while their main facility undergoes essential renovations. Site prep also included installing water, sewer and stormwater infrastructure, along with a storage equipment facility and a fire truck canopy. The work was completed in March 2024.

## Commercial Parking Lot Improvements

Aimed at boosting accessibility and aesthetics, this project will introduce landscaping islands and multi-space pay stations to all city-owned lots. The scope of work includes milling, resurfacing and re-striping, replacing single-space meters with multi-space stations and reconfiguring the layout to maximize parking availability.

Maintenance issues like ponding water and drainage will be addressed and new features such as shaded trees, irrigation and enhanced vegetation will be added to the landscape islands. The project is expected to wrap up by January 2025.

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# GRUB ON THE GO

THE HUNGRY DUTCHMAN TAKES 'SEA FOOD' TO A NEW LEVEL

**F**ood trucks have taken the culinary world by storm over the last few years. In fact, some of the most sought-after dining experiences are no longer at a five-star restaurant but out on the streets of Fort Lauderdale in a truck. But what if one could take a food truck and make it waterborne? The Hungry Dutchman answered that question a few years ago and has since been bringing high-quality, scratch-made food daily to Fort Lauderdale residents from their food boat.

Before starting The Hungry Dutchman, co-owner Amanda Coleman got her start working in food and beverage service on cruise ships, which is where she met her future co-owner, Nico Suarez. Unfortunately, when Covid hit, they were the first ones to lose their jobs which led to her getting a job with Water Taxi where she met Mike Angulo, the third co-owner of The Hungry Dutchman. It was during this time that an opportunity arose to run a water-based restaurant with her two friends and colleagues.

“I happened to be on a boat with one of my captains at Water Taxi, and he mentioned this boat in Tennessee for sale – a food boat,” Coleman said.

“It sounded like a cool opportunity, and I had a background in food service but when I looked at it, I just wasn’t sure if it was something I wanted to take on. It wasn’t until I talked to Nico and Mike that I realized that if we did this together it could work.”

With Suarez behind the grill, Angulo handling the operation and mechanics of the boat, and Coleman overseeing everything else, they officially set sail with The Hungry Dutchman whose name is a nod to the legendary ghost ship, the Flying Dutchman.

At first, the crew took the food boat down the waterways of Fort Lauderdale directly to hungry customers. However, after delays and closures due to inclement weather and even hurricanes, they realized it would benefit them and their customers to find a more permanent location. “We would be anchored at sandbars and there were times where it would get really scary with the weather, and we didn’t want to take a gamble on our business,” she said. That’s when they found an opportunity to anchor at Yacht Haven RV Park and Marina and have been serving breakfast and lunch items to their loyal customers ever since.

That hasn’t stopped them from still taking the food boat out on the open water occasionally, however.

“It’s opened other opportunities for us to really focus more on catering where we can pull up to people’s houses on the water, festivals and anywhere else that’s on the water,” she said.

Even though they’re located on the water, however, their menu has a variety of handheld dishes with international flavors making it easier to eat on a boat. So, if you’re looking to indulge in a Dutchman dog or one of their famous Crabby Patties inspired by none other than SpongeBob SquarePants, both landlubbers and seafarers can visit The Hungry Dutchman every day of the week except for Mondays. 🍷

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# BOAT SHOW BY THE NUMBERS

A LOOK AT THE WORLD'S LARGEST IN-WATER BOAT SHOW

For five days each fall, the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show (FLIBS) turns our city into the epicenter of the global boating market. Spread across seven locations and covering a total of 4.5 million square feet, the show offers a glittering spectacle of vessels of all shapes and sizes, marine-related products, and social events. However, FLIBS is much more than that.

As we prepare to celebrate the 65th anniversary of FLIBS this October 30 – November 3, 2024, it's a great time to review the impressive numbers associated with the world's largest in-water boat show.

\$1.79 billion. The economic output FLIBS generates throughout the state via purchases and expenditures at the show.

10,000+. The number of full-time Florida jobs associated with the economic output generated by the show.

\$709.7 million. The total estimated sales by Florida companies during the show. \$513.9 million from tri-county companies. \$233.9 million from Broward County companies.

These numbers leave no doubt that FLIBS is an essential component of the economic health of Fort Lauderdale, South Florida, and the state. As the owners of FLIBS, the Marine Industries Association of South Florida is proud to contribute to the state's economic success.

Of course, the show couldn't go on without outside help. That assistance comes from Informa Markets, a global

leader in tradeshow production. More specifically, Informa's Senior Vice President of Operations, Robert Correa.

Correa has helmed the production of FLIBS since 2010. His background in design, manufacturing, and procurement, plus a career in the US Air Force, gives him the strategic mindset and skills to bring FLIBS to life each year.

We asked him for insight into the numbers that go into the show each year. Besides the 2,155 action items on his master show production list, he shared the following:

- 4 million pounds of exhibitor equipment and freight (69% needed on the water)
- 7.5 miles of floating docks
- 450,000 square feet of tent space
- 300,000 square feet of temporary flooring
- 2,500+ contractors and agency workers plus 1,000+ Informa staff

- 1,000+ exhibitors, vendors, and sponsors
- 425 truckloads of equipment
- 125 miles of electrical cable

While the public enjoys five days of flawlessly executed show production, that's hardly the end of Correa's work. He notes that his team begins working on next year's show the day after the current show ends.

That's 360 days of planning to produce the next successful show. Possibly the most impressive number of all.

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## 2025 HOMESTEAD EXEMPTIONS

DID YOU ACQUIRE OR TAKE OWNERSHIP OF YOUR PROPERTY IN 2024?

If you applied and were approved for Homestead Exemption for tax year 2025, this exemption will post to your property record online in December. Once approved, Homestead Exemption automatically renews each year provided there is no change in the ownership or use of the property. Once approved, you do not need to reapply as long as the property remains your permanent residence.

If you acquired your home in 2024, the TRIM (proposed tax) Notice you received in August reflected the previous owner's exemption status. These exemptions will be removed at the end of this year. If you believe you qualify for Homestead Exemption or any other tax-saving exemptions at this property, you must complete an application in your name. Homestead Exemption does not automatically transfer from one property to another.

The timely deadline to apply for all 2025 exemptions is March 3, 2025. # A PARTY FOR THE LIVING

DAY OF THE DEAD CELEBRATION ANCIENT TRADITIONS

The annual Day of the Dead Celebration returns to Fort Lauderdale for its 15th year. It has grown into one of the greatest celebrations in North America, and once again Riverwalk will host this 3,000 year-old custom.

Jim Hammond, founder of the Puppet Network, recently talked to Go Riverwalk Magazine about the event's history and what this year's event goers can expect during the celebration.

**Q. How has the event evolved over the past 15 years?**

**A.** For 30 years, Puppet Network has delighted audiences with a variety of immersive art experiences throughout South Florida. Fifteen years ago, we brought this ultimate regional cultural event to life, (beginning with) a few puppets and one small stage. Last year, our puppets and our Fort Lauderdale event was highlighted on CBS Sunday Morning!

Ofrendas, floral tapetes, puppet performances, luminaries, Folklorico dancers, indigenous musicians, Catrinas, giant puppets and Mariachi will pop up along the

river and around town for mini performances.

**Q. What would you like people to know about this holiday that makes it unique in comparison to other holidays? Specifically, Halloween and All Saint's Day which are only days before.**

**A.** While there is a great deal of cross-pollination between international harvest festivals like Samhain and All Hallows Eve, Dia de los Muertos specifically merges what is often seen as scary or sad into a moment of celebration. Skulls are made from sugar. Papier maché skeletons are covered in flowers and butterflies.

Our grassroots event incorporates ancient tradition with a mission to produce a signature event for all ages that maintains and respects the cultural integrity of international Dia de Los Muertos traditions. The Florida Day of the Dead Celebration provides a memory for the dead and a party for the living!

**Q. Is there anything else you'd like to share?**

**A.** Day of the Dead events starts at Esplanade Park







Saturday, Nov. 2, from 3 to 8 p.m. The Folklorico Stage will have indigenous Folklorico dance and music. Guests enjoy sugar-skull face painting, mask and puppet making, Latin food trucks, artisan booths and more. Participants can take photos with Puppet Network’s giant skeleton puppets starting at 3pm at the Museum of Discovery and Science atrium.

At 6:30 p.m., the Skeleton Processional begins, featuring puppets 8 to 18 feet tall and a community of skeletons follow musicians along Fort Lauderdale’s beautiful Riverwalk, culminating at Revolution Live.

Following the Skeleton Processional, attendees arrive at Revolution Live and Backyard FTL, the Day of the Dead Street Party filled with Boneyard Bandstand DJ Stage, Food Trucks, the Craft Crypt and a Muertos Street Festival. The street festival is from 5 to 10 p.m.

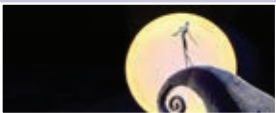

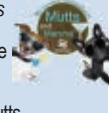

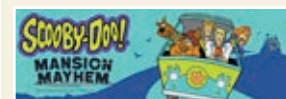
