SPOTLIGHT ON CITY'S LARGEST PARKING STRUCTURE

HIGHLIGHTS AND UPDATES FOR THE RIVERWALK CENTER GARAGE

Duilt in 1983, the Riverwalk Center Garage is the largest parking structure owned and maintained by the City of Fort Lauderdale, boasting more than 500 public metered parking spaces. The garage, originally called the City Park Garage, was renamed The Riverwalk Center Garage in 2017 in honor of the iconic Las Olas Riverwalk area of Downtown Fort Lauderdale.

Not only is the garage a convenient and popular parking location for visitors and residents, it also provides ample parking for nearby businesses and students of Broward College, Florida Atlantic University and Nova Southeastern University. In the central courtyard is the City Park Mall, a convenient hub of businesses and restaurants such as Mr. Nick's Subs, Advanced Dental Wellness and Ichimora.

Riverwalk Center Garage Improvement Project

The City of Fort Lauderdale Parking Services Division conducted a structural assessment in 2021 to develop a comprehensive improvement plan for the Riverwalk Center Garage.

The first phase of the project, completed in 2024, prioritized immediate repairs of drainage, concrete, waterproofing and railing upgrades throughout the



garage. Phase II of the project includes features such as upgrades to the Riverwalk Center Garage courtyard area, mechanical and electrical improvements and wayfinding sign installation. Project design for phase II will begin in early 2025.

New technology is also being implemented at Riverwalk Center Garage as part of a city-wide initiative, including revamping the electric vehicle charging stations and implementing a new EV charging program. For \$5 per hour, parkers can use the ParkMobile app to purchase time to charge their vehicles at the garage. A virtual monthly parking permit, applicable at all city-owned EV charging stations, is also available for purchase. Riverwalk Center Garage and Business for the Arts Partnership Mural

The Riverwalk Parking Garage now features a stunning new mural that celebrates the natural beauty and wildlife of Fort Lauderdale. This vibrant artwork, created by artists Christian and Jessica Stanley, captures the essence of the region's diverse ecosystems through the depiction of a great blue heron wading through the water, surrounded by stylized graphic mangrove trees.

This project was made possible through a partnership with the Business for the Arts of Broward, a nonprofit organization that educates the business community about the importance of Broward County's art and cultural community by building connections between cultural vitality, creative success, and economic development. By blending urban art with the beauty of nature, the mural serves as both a visual landmark and a reminder of Fort Lauderdale's environmental heritage, while enriching the City's growing public art collection and underscoring the power of public art to enhance community spaces.

Looking for available parking downtown? The Riverwalk Center Garage is available to the public 24 hours a day, seven days a week for \$3 per hour (non-resident rate) or \$1.50 per hour (resident rate).

The Parking Services Division offers two monthly public parking permit options for the garage. Permits can be purchased at the Parking Services Lobby, located at 290 N.E. Third Avenue and is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Visit www.fortlauderdale.gov/parking or contact the City's Call Center at (954) 828-8000 for more information.



CABINET CREATIONS

NATO WOOD DESIGN CREATES CUSTOM CABINETRY AND MORE

Whether you're remodeling or designing your dream home from the ground up, custom cabinetry is all the rage now. Being able to choose the type of wood your cabinets will be made from and fine tune the little details that make them fit your unique space makes this option desirable for many.

With a process as detail oriented as this one, finding the right cabinet maker can be tricky. But with Tabatta Silva and Renato Lima, the husband-and-wife team behind Nato Wood Design, you're in good hands.

Before starting Nato Wood Design, Lima spent years working in the cabinet fabrication industry. "My husband has around seven years of experience with making cabinets for a few different companies over the years. He has always wanted to start his own company but wasn't 100 percent sure he could have this type of business on his own. Then, one day, he decided to give it a shot and started getting some business," said Silva, wife and co-founder of Nato



Wood Design. The business really took off when Silva joined the team in 2022 after getting laid off from her job in the tech industry.

"I was working for a big tech company for many years, but I got laid off right after Covid. Ironically, before that, I used to work for a company that was a cabinet maker. So, I basically knew everything about cabinets, which made this transition to working with my husband feel like it was it was meant to be," she said. That was three years ago and today, Silva handles the administrative side of the business, whereas Lima is in charge of the actual cabinet fabrication.

As custom cabinet makers, their services include creating custom cabinets for kitchens, bathrooms and closets, as well as creating wooden wall panels for different areas of your space. Also, if you're not looking to replace your existing cabinets, they offer cabinet refacing, which can give your current space a lift.

But they are especially sought after for their ability to create cabinets that fit within uniquely sized spaces.

"A lot of our customers want us to build something custom-made or unique for their houses, but also, they typically reach out to us because we can build something that doesn't follow standard sizes," she said.

Each consultation starts with a visit from Silva to the space they'll be installing the cabinets.

"I usually talk with each customer to learn what styles they like and what they're looking for. Then, I'll visit with them in their home to see the space, take measurements and show them different samples that I think fit with their vision," she said.

However, even though they are custom cabinet makers, that doesn't mean they can't also accommodate clients looking for something more traditional. "I think it's important to highlight that just because we are custom cabinet makers, that doesn't mean that if the customer has a regular project that doesn't require a custom size or custom colors, we can absolutely still work with them. We prioritize ensuring each project, big or small, receives the same amount of attention," she said.

THE GOOD, THE BAD AND THE UGLY

LOOKING AT ECONOMIC INDICATORS

n a daily basis people ask me how the economy is going. All I can tell them is what I know at that point in time and based on history project the future. It's a mixed bag. A little positive and a little negative.

Here are some facts: in the middle of January our unemployment rate in Broward County was 3.4 percent and climbing. For the last eight months our year-over-year job change was -15,837. There were 37,173 open jobs at that point and 36,977 people looking for work. Unfortunately, 53,435 children in our county are living in poverty, according to the US Census Bureau.

When our Council of Economic Advisors meets this quarter, they will tell us what's happening in their market segments — health care, construction, hospitality, professional services, manufacturing, retail and more.

What we have been tracking over the last two cycles has been interest rates and inflation and how those two indicators affect our marketplace. The Federal Reserve is slowly getting to its target inflation rate of 2 percent. That has allowed several rate reductions giving our economy and consumers relief. The reality is that consumer prices and spending will take some time to moderate.

Both income and spending have been up marginally, according to The U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis. McKinsey reports consumer optimism is at its highest level since Covid, but most Americans have refrained from spending outside of necessary purchases, higher income brackets notwithstanding.

What will the economy look like under President-Elect Trump? Tariff increases, tax cuts, national deficit, international conflicts and many more issues will become more evident. What happens regionally is just as important.

We have a \$28 billion price tag on hardening for environmental impacts — warming and rising seas, heavier rainfalls, more named storms, warmer days, etc. The Chamber has been working on the solutions for 10 years and we now have a roadmap from which we can begin to chip away at what we know is occurring. There is no single funding source. Multiple revenue sources must be deployed to meet this critical demand.

While future construction projects remain on hold, hospitality and tourism is ramping up to fuel 2025. Our expansion of the convention center and the adjacent 801-key OMNI hotel will be an enormous opportunity for citywide conventions.

Broward County suggests the 1,200,000 square-foot expansion along with the hotel will "bolster our economy by more than \$200 million a year and create upwards of 1,000 full and part-time jobs when completed later this year."

Other projects like the Fort Lauderdale Hollywood International Airport expansion, including a new terminal, improved traffic systems and a people mover from FLL to Port Everglades, are welcomed improvements.

We must have answers for three other important economic items: workforce housing, a tunnel or bridge for the New River, and solutions for our homeless individuals and families.

Our mixed economic bag has the good, the bad and the ugly to use the 1966 film title with the same name.

UPDATES FOR SENIORS

AUTOMATIC RENEWAL FOR THE LIMITED-INCOME SENIOR EXEMPTION

he Limited-Income Senior Exemption renewal process no longer requires seniors to sign and return a renewal card. After the initial Senior Exemption application approval, this exemption automatically renews each year unless the senior notifies our office that they have exceeded the current year's income requirement for this exemption. People who received the Senior Exemption in 2024, whose income does not exceed the limit and are still living at the same address, do not need to send in a signed renewal card to continue receiving this exemption.

My office will mail the 2025 Senior Exemption income limit to all exemption recipients later this month.

 If your 2024 adjusted household gross income does not exceed the amount stated on the renewal card, you DO NOT need to do anything to continue receiving this valuable exemption for 2025. Your exemption will automatically be renewed provided you are still living at the same address and are still receiving Homestead Exemption. If your 2024 adjusted household gross income did exceed the income limitation, you must sign and return the renewal card to notify our office that you no longer qualify for this tax year when you receive the annual income notification from our office.

If you did not receive the Senior Exemption for 2024 at the same address and you believe you may qualify, please visit our website. You can apply for the Senior Exemption and all other tax-saving exemptions online by visiting our website at web.bcpa.net and click on "Exemptions & Classifications."

The deadline to apply for any 2025 exemption is Sept. 17, 2025.


